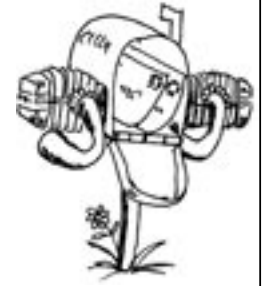

We will travel to (or at least very near) Whitehorse in the Yukon territory before turning to Skagway and the Pacific Ocean. We will cover 5,500 land miles passing through as least 5 Canadian provinces and several Canadian National Parks including Jasper and Banff. We will travel approx. 1/2 of the ALCAN Highway and once we reach Skagway, we will become an ocean going adventure for a 36 hour ride through the inside passage to Prince Rupert, British Columbia. The cost to you is 11 vacation days, a well tuned and mechanically sound ride and probably should budget about

Remember the Cruds ride is right after the May b'fast -

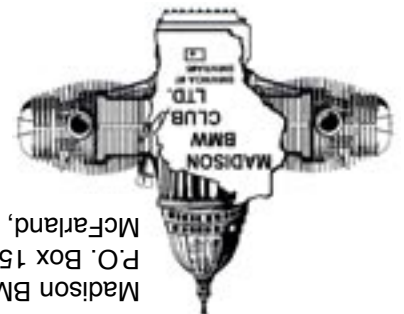
