Hi Members.

We have a new Restaurant for breakfast/meeting for May 5. It is much closer to Pine Bluff & meeting for the Slimy Crud. The room is great!

It is **SOFRA FAMILY BISTRO** 7457 Elmwood Ave, in Middleton. Arrive early! We plan to start early so we can wrap up early.

We have a downstairs meeting room that holds 40 people with 2 bathrooms on that floor. The family has owned this eatery for 18 years. They renamed it Sofra's Bistro as they previously called it The Bavarian Kitchen.



Only our Club Members & guests can eat downstairs due to the space size. Other guests that you tell about Sofra's will probably need to eat upstairs.

We will order off the menu & get individual checks with a 20% tip added. Coffee will be \$2.50 for their special blend + your meal. Carafe's of coffee will be on the tables when we arrive at 8:00 + AM. Tell your waitress so she can add coffee to your checks if you are drinking it.

We need to order promptly at 8:30 AM & leave by 10:00 AM! So please be there early. Everyone can arrive by 8:00 AM for coffee & talking.

Check out their menu: www.sofrabistro.com before coming to decide what you will be ordering to make it faster. We will only have 1 waitress so let's make it easy for her. We are on a trial basis there as it may be difficult with only one waitress doing all separate checks for us.

Sunday is their busiest day & they need the downstairs for customers at 10:00.

Parking is ample as there is a big lot across the street & one building east is the Middleton Library parking lot. I have eaten lunch there several times before & their food is fantastic! You may want to check it out & eat there before May.
