

COVID-19 Official Announcement., from the Slimey Crud FaceBook page:

First, We hope that you and your family are safe and healthy. In support of the governor's efforts to stop the spread of Covid-19, we will post our recommendation for the Spring 2020 Crud Run near the 21st of April as we get near the end date of the Governor's order and have a better understanding where this health crisis is. We are hopeful that we will have the Spring 2020 Crud Run run this year, but this is bigger than a motorcycle gathering and ride, and we will get through it together (from a distance).

We strongly encourage all riders to practice rational risk management (eg., wear a helmet), use objective data provided by healthcare experts in risk-related decision making about exposure, and follow the Governor's directives aimed at protecting public health. The CDC has issued guidance calling for no gatherings of over 50 people through May 11th. In addition, the State of Wisconsin has issued a "Safer at Home" order which we'll address separately below. As no one has a crystal ball, these dates may change over time.

Effective on 3/25/2020 at 8am, the State of Wisconsin entered a Safer at Home order. The order is in effect until April 24,2020 unless it is superseded by a future order. You may read the order by visiting: https://evers.wi.gov/Documents/COVID19/EMO12-SaferAtHome.pdf

The Official Word from the BMW Motorcycle Owners of America

The MOA has announced a date change for the Saddle Up & Ride event to June 24-27, 2021. The new date is the same weekend in June, but one year later than originally planned. Rally Chairs Corey & Becky Smith will continue to guide the largest event of the year for us and the location at the Montana State ExpoPark will remain the same for 2021.

Members and guests registered for the National Rally this summer will remain registered for the 2021 dates. If you can ride to Great Falls next year, you don't have to do anything with your registration. Your tickets, t-shirts, RV space - anything you registered for in 2020 - is still intact for the new dates.

Members who cannot attend Great Falls in 2021 or prefer to receive a refund and make a decision about 2021 later have two options - a full cash refund or an event voucher which includes a 20% value bonus. The event voucher is a coupon code that can be used for any BMW MOA event including a National Rally, MOA Getaway or Premier Training event. Event vouchers including the 20% bonus will be valid for all MOA events through December 2022.

To receive a refund or an event voucher including the 20% bonus, members should complete the Refund Request form online (https://airtable.com/shrduEBjt8UzQ7t5h) by December 31, 2020. Completing the online form allows the MOA staff to efficiently process refund requests as quickly as possible. Members who request a refund should expect confirmation by email within ten days. Beginning January 1, 2021, refunds for the National Rally will be available in accordance with the MOA's regular refund policy.

Personally, I would like to thank all of you for your support for the National Rally. Whether you have volunteered each year, registered early or sent comments about the current situation, your enthusiasm for the Rally is unmistakable. The Rally Chairs, the MOA Board of Directors and the MOA Membership Team are committed to delivering an exceptional event in 2021 as our way of saying 'thank you for being a member.'

Tom and I spent the afternoon trying to install the new battery on my K75. The old battery was from 2007, so I got my money's worth out of that one. He didn't take a picture (last fall) of how the old battery was hooked up, so it was a comedy of errors. To add to the complication, I had wiring on the old battery for a very old and long-gone radar detector. So there was some debate about just cutting them, and hmmmmm Do these wires 'here' belong to those wires up there on the handle bars? So – do ya feel lucky, punk? We cut the wire at both ends.

Eventually, hooking up the battery (should have been a 2 minute job) after moving this wire here, then there, then back again ... the clock lit up and we had power. HURRAY! Took maybe 1.5 hours.

THEN – we couldn't start the bike. Starter tried and tried, but the bike wouldn't fire. Maybe out of gas? Couldn't open the gas cap. It would not budge. The key seemed to unlock it, but it was like it was glued to the tank. I guessed a possible vapor lock, so we cooled the tank down. Still no success. (Second guessing cutting the wires at this point.) Were those

wires for something else? No. NOPE! Not possible. Finally pried the cap loose, breaking it along the way. SNAP! (never a sound you want to hear) the rubber seal to keep the tank from leaking if you ever dropped the bike, was adhered to the tank due to alcohol in the gas, and just sitting. UGH. So, we added some fresh gas, moved the broken pieces off and fitted the inner piece back in to try to make it think it was sealed

But why won't it start? Now I am guessing it's old spark plugs. But we couldn't get at the plugs. What the Hell? By now there was a cranky old woman standing my shoes, thinking, I "used to be able" to check these. By myself. At the Great River Road Rally. In the rain.

So at that point we made cocktails and walked away. Tom is looking for a YouTube video right now of how to pull those plugs, and I am reading emails.

So our question to you, should we start drinking first, before we jump into the spark plug project?
