

WORDS FROM THE PRESIDENT

In 2018 while at the BMW MOA rally in Des Moines, Iowa I met Motorcycle Relief Project representative Mike Bobbitt. I learned that MRP is a non-profit set up to provide relief for Veterans and First Responders with PTSD and other related issues by taking them on a week long structured motorcycle adventure ride. They run a couple Spring/Fall rides outside of Tucson, AZ and then a half dozen summer rides in the Pikes Peak, CO area.

I immediately applied and after going through the process was accepted in late 2018. None of the rides fit my schedule in 2019, so I booked one for 2020 and then COVID hit. 2021 was too busy, so I pushed it out until the fall of 2022 and finally was able to make it.

You need to provide your own transportation and they take care of lodging, food and provide a BMW GS to ride all week. In addition they provide a trainer all week to help participants learn proper off road techniques. Our trainer was Ben Dragoo of DART (Dragoo Adventure Rider Training).

We have all meals together, no alcohol and no phones when sitting down to eat or during our nightly group session. During group therapy they help us identify issues and how to deal with them. My assigned motorcycle for the week is the current "world's fastest BMW GS" as it holds the world record set at the Bonneville Salt Flats. It was built to raise money and awareness for MRP. They put an RT rear end on it, high flow air cleaner, Remus exhaust and a tuner. They also added NOS (nitrous) to make it capable of doing 170+ mph, but found that without NOS it was able to set the record at 147mph, which was what they did.

I truly learned a lot about myself and met some awesome people. I also learned quite a bit about adventure riding and am now hooked!! Our last day of riding was the day we worked towards all week as it consisted of a large water crossing, lots of ruts, rocks, technical off road, hills, gravel, dirt plus a 5 mile stretch of packed gravel, where I got to use some of the GS' power maintaining a speed of 70 mph (peaking at 80+ mph) all while standing on my pegs!! All I can say is WOW, as the entire experience was life changing! Also I got to see first hand that the BMW GS is the best multi-purpose/do everything motorcycle on the planet! I highly recommend MRP for those that need it and if you are looking for a place to donate this is a worthy cause doing great things!!

November 19, 2022 Annual Fall Banquet

The Board of Directors met on 10/25/22. Sam Garst reported the club finances are great. Board decided to leave \$3,000 in general fund as a 'financial floor'. They decided to give members a \$10 discount for the annual banquet. New club t-shirts will be coming with new logo at a discount for members. Club will reimburse members for taking motorcycle training classes. \$50 per member, \$500 a year total.

The GR3 cost will be \$30-35 per person. There will be brats on Friday night and hamburgers on Saturday. They decided to reduce the size of the rally pin and order 200 rather than 250. Beer will have to be donated due to regulations.

The Board decided to make Tom Van Horn a lifetime member in appreciation for all he has for the club. Congratulations Tom!

VP Dawn: She figured out she has been VP for 10 years! Tully's II will continue to be breakfast spot for the foreseeable future.

Treasurer Sue: Will have current numbers at December meeting.

Old Business: The BMW roundel couldn't be used after 2021. Our new logo was finally approved.

Elections. Chads board seat was up for 3 year renewal. He was reelected. All current officers were reelected.

Next meeting will be December 4. The January meeting will be on January 8th due to the 1st being our normal meeting. The club voted to make the annual banquet the first Saturday of November. The 2023 banquet will be November 4.
